



IMPORTANT DATES FOR LICENSED DAIRY IMPORTERS

Saturday, August 31, 2024	Last day to enter dairy products into U.S. Customs territory that may be used to qualify and establish eligibility for a calendar year 2025 license. Licensed qualifying entries verification will be only processed through ATLAS and cross checked with entries in the CBP system. For unlicensed qualifying entries, the applicant will submit an electronic copy (e.g. scanned PDF) of CBP Form 7501 to Licensing Authority.
Sunday, September 1, 2024	First day of license eligibility period for next quota year-plus one. Example: entries made on or after September 1, 2024 can be used to establish eligibility for a license for calendar year 2026.
Sunday, September 1, 2024	Last date to request globalization of a calendar year 2024 license. Application for reallocated license amounts open for calendar year 2024. Application for calendar year 2025 licenses open.
Sunday, September 15, 2024	(no exceptions!) Last transmission date for applications for reallocated license amounts for calendar year 2024.
Tuesday, October 1, 2024	(no exceptions!) Last transmission date for licensees to surrender all or the unused portion of their calendar year 2024 licenses.
Tuesday, October 15, 2024	(no exceptions!) Last transmission date for all applications for calendar year 2024 licenses.
Thursday, October 31, 2024	Exporting countries that are designating U.S. importers for calendar year 2025 must submit their designations to FAS by this date.
Sunday, December 15, 2024	(approximately) FAS issues first notice of calendar year 2025 licenses to licensees.
Tuesday, December 31, 2024	Last day for licensees to make entries to fulfill the requirement to use 85% of their calendar year 2024 license amount. Last day for which calendar year 2024 licenses are valid.
Wednesday, January 1, 2025	First day of validity for calendar year 2025 licenses.
Saturday, February 15, 2025	(approximately) FAS issues final notice of calendar year 2025 licenses to licensees.
Saturday, March 15, 2025	The license fee for each license issued is due and payable in full no later than March 15* of the year for which the license is issued. Licenses issued after March 15 of any quota year are payable in full no later than 10 days from the date of issuance. Fee payments are payable to the Treasurer of the United States and shall be made solely utilizing the electronic software designated for the purpose by the Licensing Authority.
Tuesday, July 1, 2025	Last day for an exporting country that is not designating importers for calendar year 2025 to notify FAS.
Sunday, August 31, 2025	Last day to enter dairy products into U.S. Customs territory that may be used to qualify and establish eligibility for a calendar year 2026 license.

If a deadline date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Federal holiday, the deadline will be the next business day (Section 6.36(a) of the Dairy Tariff-Rate Import Quota Licensing Regulation). This does not apply to dates of entry for eligibility.
